(Start date: July 1, 2026)

## Purpose

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide a clear and concise overview of the 2026-2027 District 77 alignment of divisions, areas, and clubs. The overview shows area totals, officer requirements, and the integration of clubs from existing Districts 14, 43, 68 and 77 into the new district structure. In addition to the listing of each club per Division and Area, descriptions of each Division and Area are provided.

## Part One: D77 – Division / Area / Club Alignment Summary

Based on the alignment team's most current review, the following alignment decisions and outcomes apply:

- The clubs currently in District 43, Division C will make up one Division.
- One Division will be a mix of clubs from District 43 and District 68. Included are the following:
  - All clubs from District 43, Division D that are moving to District 77.
  - All clubs from District 68, Areas A3 and A4.
  - One club from District 68, Area B8 located in Garyville, LA.
- One Division will consist of the remaining clubs currently in District 68 that are moving to District 77:
  - All clubs currently in District 68, Division B except for the aforementioned club in Garyville, LA.
  - All clubs currently in District 68 Area A2 that are moving to District 77.
- The clubs currently in District 77 will make up three Divisions.
  - Geographic boundaries of the new Divisions will remain the same as the current Divisions.
  - One club currently in District 14 that is moving to Phenix City, AL will be included.

## **Part Three: D77 Division and Area Descriptions**

### **D77 Division Descriptions**

- Division L covers central-to-northern Alabama. The Division includes the city of Huntsville and the outlying areas of Birmingham.
- Division M covers the metropolitan area of Memphis, Tennessee. The Division also includes northern Mississippi.
- Division N covers a region referred by some locals as “Oak Mountain”. The Division spans central Alabama, including the cities of Birmingham and Montgomery. The cities located along I-85 are also included.
- Division O stretches from Central Mississippi to Southeast Louisiana, excluding the New Orleans metropolitan area. The Division is book-ended by Jackson, Mississippi on the north end and Baton Rouge, Louisiana on the south end. The cities of Columbus, Mississippi and Aberdeen, Mississippi are also included.
- Division P covers the Gulf Coast of Florida, Alabama and Mississippi. The Division includes the cities of Pensacola, Florida, Mobile, Alabama and Biloxi, Mississippi.
- Division Q covers the New Orleans metropolitan area. The Division also stretches westward to include the cities of Morgan City and Lafayette.

Note: If you start in Huntsville, Alabama and make two backwards “Z’s” down the entire geographical area of the District, you will hit every Division in sequential order.

### **D77 Area Descriptions**

Division L:

- Area 11 starts in the city of Huntsville and extends westward. The area includes the cities of Decatur and Florence. Research Park Toastmasters, which is a hybrid club, was moved to Area 11 to better balance the clubs that are typically active in speech contests.
- Area 12 is centered around the city of Huntsville.
- Area 13 covers the Redstone Arsenal area. It also includes the Hi-Noon club, an online club that is based in Huntsville. Hi-Noon was moved to Area 13 to better balance the clubs that are typically active in speech contests.
- Area 14 covers the Birmingham outlying area, including the cities of Gadsden and Hoover. It includes a hybrid club based in Birmingham. All the clubs in the area have virtual meeting options.

#### Division M:

- Area 21 covers the Downtown Memphis area. These clubs are all geographically close to each other.
- Area 22 starts in Southern Memphis near Graceland and extends southwest along I-22. This area includes Olive Branch and Tupelo, Mississippi.
- Area 23 covers clubs outside of Downtown Memphis, primarily to the north and east.
- Area 24 primarily covers clubs located on the East side of Memphis.
- Area 25 primarily covers clubs located around the St. Jude's Medical Center. The Area also includes the Legacy Leaders club, which meets online and has members from all over the city of Memphis. This Area was chosen as a central location in the event the members wanted to meet in person.
- Area 26 primarily covers clubs located near the Memphis Airport. It also includes an Advanced club that meets online.

#### Division N:

- Area 31 covers Downtown Birmingham. All the clubs in the Area are physically located close to each other.
- Area 32 covers the area around Liberty Park in Birmingham. All the clubs in the Area are physically located close to each other.
- Area 33 covers the Birmingham outlying areas, which includes the cities of Alabaster, Pelham and Vestavia Hills. Stillman College Toastmasters was moved to Area 33 for geographical reasons and Area 33 was deemed the best cultural fit for the club.
- Area 34 covers Montgomery along with the clubs to the east. The area includes the cities of Enterprise, Phenix City and Tuskegee. Note there is an existing relationship between the Coffee County Toastmasters club and Monarch Toastmasters that necessitates the two clubs being in the same Area.

#### Division O:

- Area 41 covers the western part of Jackson, Mississippi and extends westward to Vicksburg.
- Area 42 covers the eastern part of Jackson, Mississippi and includes a virtual club and an advanced club.

- Area 43 covers the cities of Columbus and Aberdeen. These clubs all originated from Jackson. There are plenty of existing relationships among these clubs. These clubs have to be aligned together and have to be aligned with Jackson.
- Area 44 covers the Baton Rouge, Louisiana metropolitan area. It also includes the Marathon Petroleum club in Garyville, Louisiana. Most of the members of Marathon live in the Baton Rouge area.
- Area 45 covers the prison clubs located in Louisiana. These clubs are all relatively close to Baton Rouge. The area also includes the Rabble Rousers advanced club. Most of the “outside world” support for the prison clubs comes from Rabble Rousers.

#### Division P

- Area 51 consists of online clubs. The Area includes Tower Toastmasters, which is a hybrid club located at a bank that has branches in South Alabama. The Area also includes the Talk of the Town club. The club’s location is listed as Opelika, Alabama, although in reality it’s an online club whose members are from various places.
- Area 52 covers the Alabama and Mississippi Gulf Coasts.
- Area 53 covers the Pensacola metro area.
- Area 54 covers the Florida Panhandle east of Pensacola.

#### Division Q

- Area numbering starts at the North shore of Lake Pontchartrain and makes a crescent around Lake Pontchartrain.
- Area 61 covers the North shore of Lake Pontchartrain. The Area includes the cities of Covington, Mandeville and Slidell. It also includes the Golden Crescent Advanced Club and the Big Easy Toasters. Both clubs meet online.
- Area 62 covers Downtown New Orleans.
- Area 63 covers the Western part of New Orleans, which includes the cities of Kenner and Metairie.
- Area 64 covers all clubs in the Division west of the Mississippi River. The Area includes the cities of Bridge City, Morgan City and Lafayette. The Lafayette clubs were placed here as New Orleans was deemed to be a better cultural fit for them than Baton Rouge. All clubs in this Area offer online meetings.
